The Court will not honor agreements by the parties to modify the briefing schedule set forth in the Rules of Civil Procedure unless it is notified by stipulation in writing of the terms of the agreement before the rule-imposed deadline expires **and** the motion is fully briefed at least 5 judicial days prior to the hearing.

Intervenors' counsel advise the Court that an Answer and Counterclaim will be filed on **Monday, April 7, 2014.**

Discussion is held regarding the current expert witness deadline and whether an extension to that deadline should be granted.

The Court does not believe that any factual discovery obtained by the Intervenors would impact the opinion of Defendant's expert witness.
