

THE SAFE PARKS AND RESPONSIBLE VEHICLE OPERATION ACT

- Section 1.** The Council finds that vehicles create safety problems when they are operated in parks and further finds that the best solution is to ban any and all vehicles from municipal parks.
- Section 2.** No vehicles of any kind shall be allowed in any municipal park. Any person who brings or drives a vehicle into one of these parks shall be guilty of a misdemeanor which may be punished by a fine not exceeding \$500 or by a two-day incarceration in municipal jail, or both.
- Section 3.** “Vehicle” for purposes of this law means any mechanism for conveying any person from one place to another, including automobiles, trucks, motorcycles, and motor scooters. *Provided that*, bicycles shall be allowed in the park, so long as they are being pushed or carried and not ridden.
