

The Act to Get Kolaches and Donuts for Professor Hester's Favorite Class (2014)

Enacting Clause: Effective on the date of enactment of this Act, there is established the Act to Get Kolaches and Donuts for Professor Hester's Favorite Class. This statute has become law.

Short title: *Snack Attack Act of 2014*

Statement of Purpose, Preamble, Findings:

Professor Hester generously offers to purchase at least \$100.00 USD worth of donuts and kolaches for his Section A Statutory Interpretation Class to be delivered on Thursday, January 23rd 2014 at 2:30 p.m. Central Standard Time. The Class finds that the purchase of donuts and kolaches will be adequate to accommodate the various dietary needs and preferences of the Class.

Definitions:

Kolache: a type of pastry that holds a link of sausage or ground sausage and cheese.

Donut: a small fried cake of sweetened dough, typically in the shape of a ball or a ring.

Principal Operative/Implementation provision

We have \$100 to spend on donuts and kolaches for the students to consume in class on Thursday, January 23, 2014. On Thursday, January 23, 2014, Professor Hester will purchase \$40.00 worth of kolaches flavored sausage and cheese, \$40.00 flavored sausage and \$20.00 worth of sugar glazed donuts from Shipley Donuts at 3726 Scott St. Houston, Texas 77004, and deliver them to classroom TUII 211 at 2:30 P.M.

If Professor Hester does not purchase and deliver the specified donuts/kolaches to The Class for the specified day and exact time, the class for that day and the following months are cancelled.

Subordinate operative provision: At least two of the kolaches (as specified in the "Principle operative provision" section of this statute) will have no dairy products, including cheese, or anchovies.

Preemption provisions: This Act preempts all prior, present, and future acts pertaining to the subject matter of the donuts and kolaches, unless a future act made by this body expressly preempts this Act.

Savings clause

If any clause is determined to be unenforceable, the remainder of the statute or contract will remain intact and enforceable.

Temporary provisions

Students will either get one donut OR one kolache each.

In the event that Shipley's does not have donuts and/or kolaches, the delivery will be postponed until Thursday, January 30th.

After the regular class schedule elapses Professor Hester will still be required to give donuts and kolaches to his Stat. Interp students, at ALL review sessions for each and every individual student who attends and after the exam at 12:00noon

Expiration Date: May 8th after exams at 12:00 noon

Effective Date: Tuesday, January 21, 2014

Dispute Resolution Clause: All disputes will be decided by an arbitration board comprised completely of students in Professor Tracy Hester's Statutory Interpretation and Regulation class. All decisions are final. The composition of the board will be decided by the class in a committee of the whole.
