

## **Stephen T. Zamora Memorial Scholarship**

Up to \$10,000 Scholarship

The Stephen T. Zamora Memorial Scholarship offers financial assistance to a well-qualified, Mexican law student, who has earned a non-U.S. law degree and is or will be enrolled in the LL.M. Program at the University of Houston Law Center.

### **Guidelines:**

1. Scholarship applicant(s) must be a qualified Mexican LL.M. student pursuing studies at the University of Houston Law Center
2. The qualified student(s) must be in good academic standing in accordance with the standards set by the University of Houston Law Center LL.M. Student Handbook
3. Priority given to Mexican applicants who have a Law Degree from a Mexican University
4. Preference may be given to applicants demonstrating financial need and/or considerable family obligations
5. Funds can be used to cover expenses for tuition, books, fees, and/or supplies.

### **Application Materials:**

Student should submit a resume, letter of interest and an unofficial transcript. The letter can address financial need and/or considerable family obligations, and plan for completing the LL.M. degree at UH Law Center.
