Do Now: Lawmaking Review - ANSWER KEY

Assuming the Bill begins in the House, order the legislative process

5	In the Senate, the bill is assigned to another committee and, if released, debated and voted on.			
4	If the bill passes by simple majority (218 of 435), the bill moves to the Senate.			
1	A Representative sponsors a bill.			
3	If released by the committee, the bill is put on a calendar to be voted on, debated or amended.			
7	The resulting bill returns to the House and Senate for final approval.			
8	The President then has 10 days to veto the final bill or sign it into law.			
2	The bill is assigned to a committee for study.			
9	The Bill is now a Law!			
6	If the Senate makes changes, the bill must return to the House for concurrence.
