- All faculty, staff, and students at your university receive a **50% discount** on individual ASIL memberships. Discounted student membership is \$30. Discounted regular membership is \$117.50.
- To sign up, visit http://www.asil.org/membership and click "JOIN ASIL". On the payment, page, you will be able to enter the discount code: ASILACADPART.
- To renew your membership, after logging into your account, click on My Account and under User
- Menu select Membership Renewal Adjustments. Enter the Promo Code ASILACADPART then click Show My Price. If the original invoice still appears, click Remove Item and you should then see the discounted invoice to pay.
