Dr. Gabriel Cavazos Villanueva serves as Interim Director of the North American Consortium on Legal Education (NACLE) and is Associate Dean for Social Sciences and Humanities at Tecnológico de Monterrey, Campus Monterrey.



Throughout his career, Cavazos Villanueva has worked in various areas of public administration at municipal, state, and federal levels, including advising the Senate. He is currently Professor of Law at the Tecnológico de Monterrey, Campus Monterrey, where he has also been Director of the Master in International Business Law, and Master of International Law of the EGAP. In the same Institute, he has been professor and researcher at the Virtual University Law Center for Inter – American Trade (Jurici).

Cavazos Villanueva participates in binational panels established under the settlement system of international commercial disputes of Chapter XIX of NAFTA and serves as a consultant in various areas of international law. He has been published in journals such as Tulane Law Journal and is a member of the Editorial Committee of the Mexican Comparative Law Bulletin. Cavazos Villanueva has also been involved in various seminars in the United States, Canada, the Netherlands, Belgium, Luxembourg, Germany, and Panama. Finally, he has been a visiting professor at Baylor University (Texas, United States).
